Our first required meeting and practice will be on **August 5, 2019**. We will meet at the Kennedy driving range restaurant at **12:30 p.m**. We will collect yellow tickets (signifying that all registration steps are complete), preview the year, and outline objectives and expectations. The meeting is mandatory and you need to bring the following completed forms and items:

- Yellow Ticket, instructions are on the TJ Sports Registration page (web link: http://tjhs.dpsk12.org/athletics-home-2/). Complete all steps and bring your Yellow Ticket (received from Athletics department) to the first practice. Steps in the Yellow Ticket process include:

Positions on the tournament team will be determined during the first week of tryouts. Here is what will be included in the fee for each team:

Tournament team (Varsity): 8-week season; start August 5, state tournament end of September

- DPS pay to play fee: \$60.00
- 7 x 18-hole tournament rounds (\$10/each): \$70.00
- 2 x 18-hole practice rounds (\$10/each): \$20.00
- 8 x 9-hole practice rounds (\$5/each): \$40.00
- 8 x range balls, medium bucket (\$3/each): \$20.00

TOTAL = \$210

Development team (Spartans): 6-week season, start August 5, finish Sept. 12.

- DPS pay to play fee: \$60.00
- 2 x 9-hole tournament rounds (\$5/each): \$10.00
- 12 x 9-hole practice rounds (\$5/each): \$60.00
- 8 x range balls, medium bucket (\$3/each): \$20.00

TOTAL = \$150

- We want everyone to participate so if there is a problem with the course fee please see me and let me know.

TJ golf polo shirts that players keep will be available for purchase. In past years the shirts cost \$35-\$40.

- Summer short-game log (http://golf.tjcctweb.com/packet/TJ_SummerShortgame.pdf) bring your results log of summer practice to get TJ Golf prizes.
- You must provide your own golf equipment, but we do have some club sets that you can borrow for the season. See Mr. Fornstrom or Mr. Smith if you need clubs. The school district and TJHS will pay for green fees and golf balls for tournament use.

Athletes <u>will not</u> be allowed to practice without a **Yellow Ticket**. **At 2 p.m. on August 5, we will have our first practice.** During the first week, returning players will have a stroke-play tournament with two 18-hole rounds. This tournament will determine placement for the initial tournaments. Beginning players will receive instruction and play the par 3 or West course.

Unfortunately, high school golf is a very short season. We will only be able to fit in 15 full-squad practices. This means that summer will be the time to improve your golf game. You need to be ready to shoot low scores when the season begins. Consider taking the following steps to speed your improvement.

- Practice your putting and short game. This is the quickest way to improve scores. 30 minutes three times a week is a great start. Record your results in the attached practice log (or make your own log) and bring it to the first practice to get TJ Golf prizes.
- Play golf! You will get out of the game what you put into it, so get out with your friends and have fun playing the game. Some members of the team will be getting together for **non-mandatory** sessions. This will be a chance for you to play with your peers and improve as a team. There is information on the back for junior passes at Common Ground G.C. and reduced rates for juniors on Denver courses.
